

Bay and Beyond

The Valhalla 28 Bay resets the standard for high-performance inshore boats. She draws only 18 inches, giving anglers the ability to stalk flats and backcountry bays. With a double-stepped hull and 18-degree deadrise, she also runs confidently to nearshore reefs. At 28' 1" with a 9' 3" beam, the V-28 delivers more space, fishability and versatility than any bay boat in her class.

Power choices include Mercury or Yamaha, up to 600 horsepower. A 130-gallon fuel capacity provides excellent range, and standard hydraulic jack plates boost performance and maneuverability. An integrated engine setback increases deck space while optimizing efficiency, buoyancy and handling. Rod holders are everywhere – built into the helm seating module, flush in the coamings and in the sides of the console seat – giving you a place for a rod no matter where you are on the boat.

The V-28 is built entirely in-house for turnkey-ready delivery. With a sleek profile, flawless finish and signature lines, your Valhalla will draw attention wherever she goes – turning heads whether you're cruising to a waterfront restaurant or running out for a day of fishing.

The V-28 Bay brings big-boat engineering and quality to the inshore world – and expands the possibilities for anglers everywhere.





Serious Business

The V-28 Bay gives anglers room and rigging to do it all. The recessed forward casting deck is built for action – cast to the flats, throw a net with ease or operate the latest trolling motor for silent maneuverability.

With Power-Poles deployed, anglers can toss bait or fight fish from the corner with stability and confidence. The entire centerline hatch lifts to reveal the lazarette, where the Hooker Sea Chest, pumps and systems are installed.

Twin 25-gallon aft live wells, internally lit and pressurized, keep bait fresh through long days. Dual in-deck fishboxes plumbed for overboard discharge and stainless Gemlux rod holders and hardware round out a layout built for serious fishing.







Helm and Comfort

The helm of the V-28 Bay blends technology with tradition. A recessed black acrylic dash holds dual Garmin or Simrad displays up to 19 inches, or a single 22-inch Garmin. The teak helm pod with Edson wheel carries the custom paddle shifters, putting fingertip control of trim and jack plates at hand.

At the stern, the casting deck features a centerline flip-up bench seat. The aft live wells can also be used as drink boxes. Helm seating starts with a polished aluminum leaning post with Yeti cooler, rod holders and storage. An optional fiberglass module adds an upholstered bench, tackle storage and a slide-out Valhalla cooler, with Release Marine and Llebroc upgrades available. A private head is accessed through a port-side door, with room to move and excellent service access to the batteries and helm wiring.

The forward casting deck holds three storage lockers that are well lit and can be used for dry storage; the outboard lockers can also be utilized as fishboxes with overboard drainage. The boat's third live well (28 gallons) on centerline features an integrated clear lid. The console seat has an insulated drink box; outboard on each side are dedicated rod lockers with reel pads. Every inch of space is well thought out and used to its fullest potential.

Premium upholstery, a faux teak toe rail and yacht-level finish provide the same high level of comfort, refinement and performance that define every Valhalla.
